

In the event, the applicable statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council permits such programme(s), the HEI shall submit the approval or recommendation of the said authority or council, for consideration of the Commission.
- That the Higher Education Institution shall ensure compliance to other relevant UGC Regulations and norms issued by the relevant statutory/regulatory bodies from time to time.
- 8. That for the programmes falling under the ambit of a statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council, the Higher Educational Institution has the approval or recommendations of the respective statutory or regulatory authority or regulatory council for offering the programme(s) in Open and Distance Learning mode or Online mode, as applicable; and has also submitted the same to UGC along with the application.
