INSTITUTE OF CORRESPONDENCE COURSES, UNIVERSITY OF KASHMIR, SGA

The Institute of Correspondence courses was established in the year 1976. The Institute initially started conducting the courses in Arts and Commerce at the Under-graduate level. At the time of its establishment, the following academic staff was provided for the Institute:-

1. Director--- One
2. Lecturers ---Three

In the year 1978, B.Ed. course through correspondence was introduced. However, no academic staff was provided to conduct this course.

The Institute instituted LL.B. 2-year (Academic) Course through correspondence in the year 1978 and one Co-ordinator and Asstt: Co-ordinator were provided in 1978 and 1979 respectively.

The Institute introduced Hindi/Urdu course in the year 1977-78. The Course was a sequel to the decision of the State Government to make the teachers working in the Education Department bilingual. However, no academic staff was provided to conduct this course.

The University Council gave its sanction to introduce a Certificate Course in Library and Information Science through Institute of Correspondence Courses and subsequently the Certificate course in Library and Information Science course was introduced in the year 1984, without any academic staff to co-ordinate its activities.

With the growing strength on the rolls of B.Ed. course, the Institute requested the State Government to provide academic staff to conduct this course. The need was so much felt that the State Government deputed one lecturer from Government College for Women, M.A. Road, Srinagar to help the Institute to conduct the B.Ed. Course. This lecturer was drawing her salary from the Education Department of State Government but working in the Institute. However, in the year 1983, one post of a lecturer was provided in the discipline of the Education.

The present position in the Institute is that there is only one lecturer to look after the B.Ed. course. It is pertinent to point out that the enrolment of B.Ed. Course has risen from 244 in 1978 to 395 in the year 1985. It is not practically possible for one teacher to look after this course. Moreover, there is a lot of field work involved in this course. Therefore, there is a great need that one more academic member i.e. in the grade of a College Lecturer may be provided to look after this course. The incumbent would co-ordinate the activities of the course outside the Institute viz. conduct of contact programme, conduct of practice of teaching, contact resource personnel and other such activities as are assigned to him by the Institute.

There is also a great need to have one more Lecturer in the discipline of Urdu at the undergraduate level. This lecturer would apart from helping in the conduct of undergraduate course, also help in the conduct of Hindi/Urdu course run by the Institute. The Institute is further planning to introduce some courses in Urdu language. Therefore, the Lecturer in Urdu would be very much essential to run such courses.



it is, therefore, submitted that the following academic staff may be provided to the Institute as early as possible.

1. Co-ordinator for B.Ed. Course;
2. Lecturer in Urdu.

The proposal is placed before the Departmental Committee of Institute of Correspondence Courses.

The Departmental Committee strongly recommends the creation of these posts.

Item NO: 2 To peruse the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 13(4) of the Kashmir and Jammu Universities Act, 1969, in having authorized the creation of two posts of Lecturers in the Department of Distance Education each in the pay scale of Rs. 1000-2000.

Note: The Chairman, Distance Education Department requested for creation of the following posts in the Department:-

1. Co-ordinator for the B.Ed. Course ... One
2. Lecturer in Urdu ... One

The justification given by the Chairman for creation of the said posts is contained in the annexure to this item. The Financial Advisor's concurrence reproduced below, was sought in the matter:-

"I agree to the creation of two posts of Lecturers in the scale of Rs. 1000-2000 (both the posts being designated as Lecturers instead of one as Co-ordinator as proposed) subject to the condition that no additional grant for the purpose would be provided."

In view of the urgency expressed by the Chairman, Department of Distance Education, the Vice-Chancellor, in exercise of the powers vested in him under Section 13(4) of the Kashmir and Jammu Universities Act, 1969 authorized the creation of the two posts of Lecturers in the department, one for the discipline of B.Ed and the other for Urdu, in the pay scale of Rs. 1000-2000. Orders were accordingly issued on 1.10.1985. The matter is placed before the Council for perusal.

To ratify the action taken by the Vice-Chancellor in having authorized change of nomenclature of Centre of Distance Education as “**Directorate of Distance Education**”.

Note:

The proposal was mooted by the Liason Officer, Centre of Distance Education Jammu chapter mentioning therein that with the growing influence and acceptance of Distance Learning throughout the Country, and in view of the fact that the Centre has multiple study Centers/Sub Centers spread through out the State, the name “Centre of Distance Education” somehow sounds and looks odd, when it appears in repetition. The Liason Officer thus suggested an appropriate name for the Centre as “**Directorate of Distance Education**” as already exists in the University of Jammu.

The issue stands also discussed by the Advisory Board of Centre of Distance Education at its meeting held on 28-11-2007, whereat it was resolved to endorse the proposal for renaming the Centre as “**Directorate of Distance Education**”.

Accordingly, the matter was submitted to the Vice-Chancellor for authorization and approval for issuance of necessary notification to this effect. The Vice-Chancellor authorized the change in the nomenclature and a notification dated 30-03-2008 in the subject matter was accordingly issued.

Hence, the matter is placed before the University Council for ratification.
