A plagiarism certificate, automatically generated through recognized plagiarism detection software, must be submitted along with the full paper after the acceptance of the abstract.

Formatting Requirements

(APA Style to be strictly followed):

- Abstract: Maximum of 250 words, accompanied by at least three keywords.
- Full Paper: Approximately 3,000 words.
- Font: Times New Roman, size 12.
- Spacing and Margins: 1.5 line spacing, with margins of 1.5 inches on the left and 1 inch on the right.

Important Deadlines:

- Last date for submission of abstracts: **30th October 2025**
- Last date for submission of full-length papers: **5th November 2025**
