# One Day Induction-Cum-Orientation Program Proceedings B.Ed. Trainees 23rd April 2024

The Centre for Distance and Online Education conducted a one-day inductioncum-orientation programme on 23rd April 2024 in the Conference Hall of the Centre. Dr. Syed Ishfaq, Assistant Professor, conducted the proceedings of the Orientation programme. Prof. Shawkat Ahmed Shah, Director, Centre for Distance and Online Education, welcomed the august gathering. In his illuminating speech, he highlighted the role of Distance Education in fulfilling the societal obligation of "Reaching the Unreached". He said that the Centre is committed to creating a vibrant Distance Education System where an inquisitive distant learner finds the right ambience to have a mind opened by wonder rather than the one closed by a myopic outlook. He advised the learners to sit and do serious homework to complete the assigned tasks within the stipulated time. He recognized the learners as a part of an extended family of Distance Education. Prof. Tariq Ahmed Chisthi, former Dean and Director, School of Open Learning, presented a historical journey of the Centre from sapling to a shady Chinar before the audience. He impressed upon the learners to gain mastery over the basic teaching skills.
